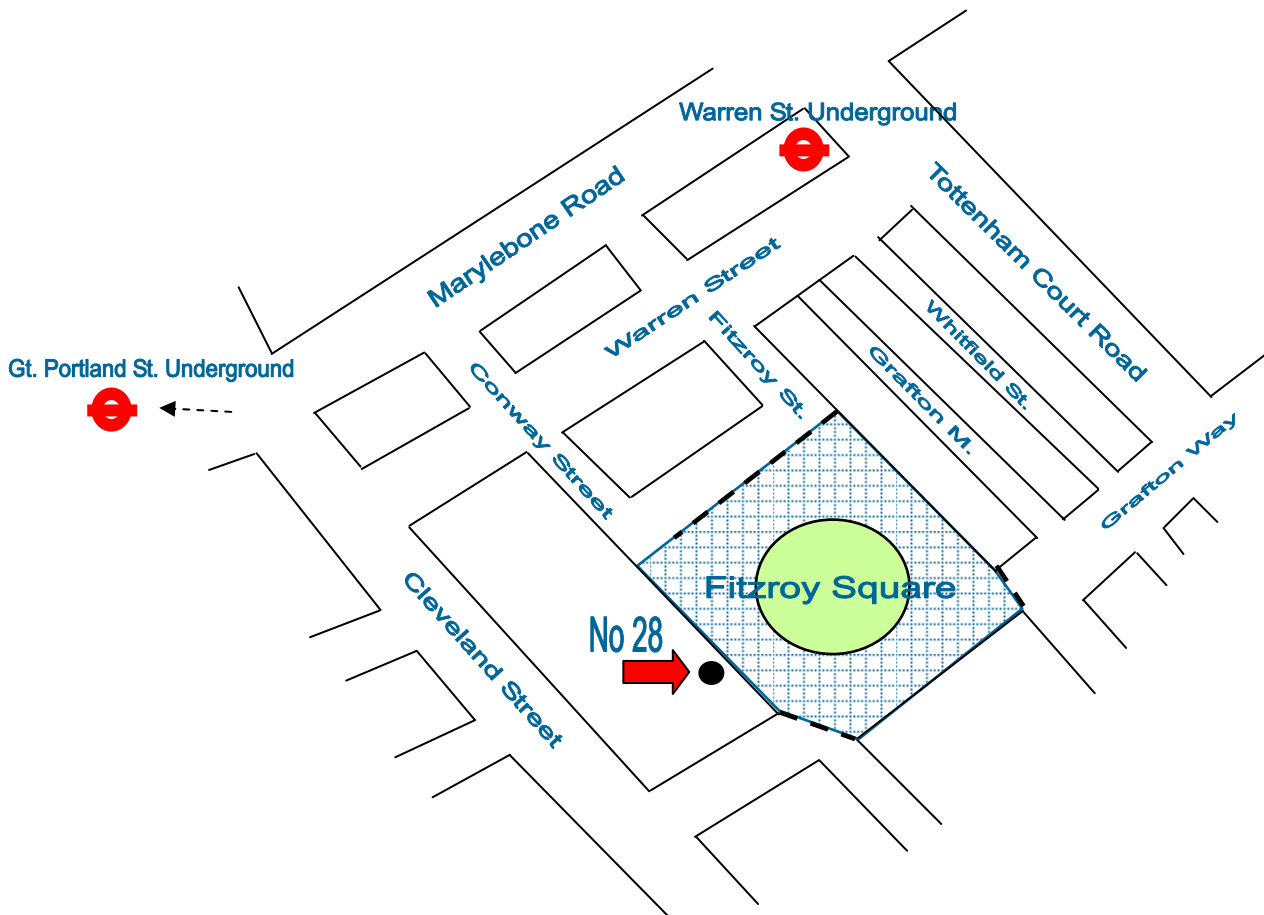




Map and parking information

Fitzroy Square is mostly pedestrianised, although part of it can be entered by car from Conway Street (North West of Fitzroy Square), off Warren Street.

The nearest British Rail stations are Euston, Euston Square and King's Cross.

The nearest underground stations are Warren Street (Victoria & Northern Lines) and Great Portland Street (Metropolitan & Circle Lines).



Parking

Fitzroy Square is pedestrianised but can be entered, for drop offs, from Conway Street, which is off Warren Street.

Disabled parking is available for ORANGE & BLUE BADGE holders in Grafton Way, which runs between Cleveland Street and Gower Street, south east of Fitzroy Square (but unfortunately not in the small part of Grafton Way that is closest to 28).

For GREEN BADGE holders there is a bay in Conway Street, in the part that is south of the square. The building has a few steps so if you have any special requirements please contact the office beforehand.

There are Pay & Display parking bays in Conway Street and the surrounding area operating between 8.30 - 6.30 Monday to Saturday. Maximum stay is 2 hours at £4.00 per hour. There are some meters also.
